### **Brief Explanation:**

State and federal laws require that all students who have been identified as English Learners be assessed for English language proficiency (ELP) annually. The English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) is the state's designated test of ELP.

Planning process for the computer-based Summative ELPAC:

- 1. The state testing window for the computer- based Summative ELPAC opens February 1, 2021 and ends May 31, 2021. The SDUSD recommended time frame is from February 1, 2021 to April 9, 2021.
- 2. All Summative ELPAC Text Examiners must complete **required annual training**. Instructions on how to complete the online Moodle training are provided in **Attachment A** (see the links at the top of page).
  - a. All Test Examiners must **email** their certificate of completion to <u>ola@sandi.net</u> prior to administering the Summative ELPAC.
  - b. Visiting and retired teachers who wish to be certified in SAMS, must also **email** certification of completion to Lynda Ensign (llawrence@sandi.net).
- 3. All English learners must complete all four domains (Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing) of the computer-based Summative ELPAC.

- a. All four domains are administered online.
- b. Speaking domain must be administered **one-on-one** for grades TK-12 and scored locally.
- c. All domains for grades TK-2 must be administered one-on-one,
  - i. With the exception of Grade 2 Writing, which *may* be administered in groups. (We are awaiting CDE/ETS guidance on group size.)
  - ii. TK-2 Writing is paper-based. (Materials from Assessment Services).
