


STOP Contact PPO before you start on the project!

PPO can help with:

- Site assessments to ensure future District plans don't interfere with your project. For example don't put your garden in a location that will be used for future classrooms or is needed to access utilities.
- Compliance with District standards to ensure the project is completed safely and will withstand the test of time.
- Responsibility reviews to detail the site's maintenance and upkeep obligations.
- Adherence with collective bargaining agreements to avoid grievances.

All proposed volunteer projects require a **SELF HELP FORM**, available at https://www.sandiegounified.org/site-self-help-projects. Projects and/or donations will be reviewed by maintenance planning staff for approval.
